OCEAN REEF & Shark Week

During Shark Week 2009, (August 2-8) on the Discovery Channel, OCEAN REEF was featured by Jeff Kurr during "Shark After Dark".

A common question raised is: Do sharks feed after dark? Jeff Kurr and his team took to the cages and open waters armed with underwater cameras and OCEAN REEF full face masks with communications.

Using night and thermal vision, the team was able to view the sharks as they fed both above and below the surface. The OCEAN REEF M105 surface unit was used by Jeff to communicate with his team while they prepared to dive the deep waters with the Six Gill sharks. Rarely seen by humans, the Six Gill sharks are somewhat of a mystery.

While underwater, Jeff spoke on camera with clarity and ease using the OCEAN REEF GSM (Global Submarine Messenger) while in the safe confines of the shark cage. This dive was an amazing opportunity for Jeff and his entire team to be up close and personal with such a large species seldom seen on camera.

With plenty of fascinating footage of the Great White, Sand Shark, Lemon Shark, Tiger Shark and more... Jeff's use of OCEAN REEF products at multiple depths shows our versatility and comfort for all divers.

M101A — Underwater Receive Only Unit



Developed as a receive only unit, the OCEAN REEF M101A is perfect for multiple diving scenarios when it is not necessary for everyone to use a full face mask with communications. However, the M101A has the ability of fitting on both full face masks and conventional mask straps.

The M101A automatically acti-

vates once submerged in water. With a strong reception, this unit may be worn on or off the mask, or as a handheld for multiple divers to listen to.

Instructor/Student:

The M101A acts as a teaching device in situations where a dive instructor needs to be able to communicate with his/her students, however, does not need them to have response capabilities. The instructor can easily speak to the students using any OCEAN REEF underwater communication device, thus allowing students to hear and follow instructions via the M-101A.

Guided Tour:

Many resorts and popular dive locations offer underwater guided tours. The tour guide may use an underwater communication device, such as the GSM, and lead the tour without having to use hand signals. The M101A will allow the divers to hear the tour guide and follow instructions to provide a safe and enjoyable dive.

OCEAN REEF offers the M101A by itself or as part of a pack.

Because the instructor can audibly communicate with the students while underwater, they may make adjustments without having to surface. Oahu, Hawaii — Sea Tiger Wreck



Sea Tiger Shipwreck Oahu, Hawaii

In the warmer waters (74°-78°) of Hawaii, beside the luscious island of Oahu, rests the Sea Tiger. Between 75 and 100 feet, this dive provides a more advanced and challenging experience.

The Sea Tiger is around 180 feet in length and has created a magnificent artificial reef. A Chinese owned vessel, the United States Coast Guard confiscated and later auctioned off this piece of history. After being sunk in 1999, she later become one of the most popular wreck dives in the area!

Being a metal ship, this dive site does not come without its risks. Jagged edges and small spaces can cause unwanted consequences. Be sure to familiarize yourself with the area before diving further down than the ship's topside. This site is not for the beginner!! It is considered a more advanced dive and should be regarded as such.
