

Rum Runner Dive Shop Dive the Mighty "O"

Everybody's been asking about diving the USS Oriskany CV/CVA 34 (you know, the BIG 911 foot long aircraft carrier built in 1945, refitted for service in 1950, saw action in the Korean conflict and the Viet Nam war, now sunk 25 miles off the coast of Pensacola, Florida).

This will be a long weekend trip with two days of diving and here are the particulars:

Dates: April 21 & 22, 2007

Travel days April 20 & 23.

Diving: MBT Divers, Pensacola www.mbtdivers.com

Boat departs each day at 8:00am for a 5 to 6 hour day.

These are ADVANCED Dives. If you are not certified to at least an advanced diver level, contact the shop for training options.

Cost: \$145.00 / day includes 2 - 1 tank dive each day on the USS Oriskany.

Tanks are not included, air tank rental \$7.50, Nitrox \$14.00.

We have booked the boat with a maximum capacity of 16 divers.

Hotel: We have a block of rooms reserved April 20 to 23.
